TAN SRI DATO' IR. JAMILUS HUSSEIN

Chairman of Construction Industry Development Board Malaysia (CIDB) / President / CEO of KLIA Consultancy Services Sdn Bhd

Tan Sri Dato' Ir. Jamilus Hussein has well over 40 years experience in the design, construction and management of building and infrastructure projects. He is a recognized personality in the construction industries not only for his experience and technical knowledge but also as one who constantly advocates and disseminates sound project management practices. One of his outstanding achievements is, as Managing Director of KLIA Berhad, his leadership in harnessing the efforts of a large number of professionals of diverse disciplines to complete the huge technically sophisticated airport project the "KL International Airport". Prior to the KLIA project, he has held various key management positions in the Public Works Department, Malaysia: State Director of Pahang, Terengganu and Perak and also Director of the Road Division.

He is an ardent believer of the need to upgrade the project management and technical capabilities of professionals in the country and forwards this ends, despite his busy schedule, he regularly gives talks at seminar and universities. He sits in many governing committees on the construction industry in the country; among them are Chairman of Construction Industry Development Board Malaysia and Chairman of Industrialized Building System.

PROF. PETER BARRETT

Professor of Management in Property and Construction

Peter is President of the UN-established International Council for Research and Innovation in Building and Construction (CIB) involving 2000 experts in 60 countries. He is a past Director of Salford's top rated, 6* Research Institute for the Built and Human Environment and is currently Chairman of the £5M EPSRC funded, Salford Centre for Research and Innovation. From 2001 - 2008 Professor Barrett was Pro-Vice Chancellor for Research with overall responsibility for all research across Salford University, which in this period grew from involving 38% to 60% of academic staff.

Peter is a Fellow of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors and in 1989 was the first Chartered Building Surveyor to gain a PhD. He has since supervised and supported a wide range of Post Graduate students. To date he has produced over one hundred and seventy single volume publications, refereed papers and reports, and has made over one hundred and ten presentations in around sixteen countries. Professor Barrett has undertaken a wide range of research, typified by a management focus around real world problems using a range of hard and soft research methods. He is currently focusing on the theme of Revaluing Construction with a particular interest in the links between Senses, Brain and Spaces.

PROF. MUSTAFA ALSHAWI

Director of the Research Institute for the Built & Human Environment and an Associate Head of Research of the School of the Built Environment at the University of Salford, UK.

Mustafa Alshawi holds many international advisory posts in various countries and is a consultant on UN Habitat and World Bank projects. He is also the Editor in Chief of the international journal of "Construction Innovation: Information, Process, Management", published by "Emerald", and the author of over a hundred publications in variety of fields including databases, object oriented databases, IT strategies, CAD, planning automation, IS success factors and e-readiness. He has recently published a book to provide a holistic view on the readiness of organizations to successfully embrace IT into their work practices. The title of the book is "Rethinking IT in Construction and Engineering: Organizational readiness."

Professor Alshawi is the founder of five innovative postgraduate courses, in IT and Construction Management, ranging from PG Diploma, MSc, Master of Research and PhD (without residence). He has managed a number of large research projects over his research career funded by (EPSRC, DTI, EU, NWUA and industry). His leading work in management of information in collaborative environments, integrated databases in construction and computer integration are internationally known.

PROF. DR. DEAN T. KASHIWAGI

Dean Kashiwagi is the creator of the Performance Information Procurement System (PIPS) and the Performance Information Risk Management System (PIRMS). He is an expert in Industry Structure, the delivery of services; supply chain management, leadership/management, and the deductive logic based Information Measurement Theory (IMT).

Dean is the director of the PBSRG, home of the CIB W117, and foremost expert in best value/performance based procurement. They have conducted over 600 tests of \$2.3B of services. Dean is a prolific author of over 150 refereed conference and journal papers.

Dean has recently been awarded a Fulbright Scholarship to test the cutting edge concepts in Botswana at the University of Botswana. Botswana is a challenge due to it being a developing country. Currently he is a professor at Arizona State University in USA.
